Cover slide	Hi there, My name is Tobias and I am the Project Manager for the Action with Africa program working for Enactus Germany. It's a pleasure to have your project participate in the Action with Africa Challenge 2023 and this video is here to help <u>you</u> prepare your final submission documents.
	Remember that the Action with Africa Education Module must be completed by three project team members. However, due to technical issues it is no longer required to upload certificates of participation and the deadline to watch all videos by 30 April 2023 does no longer apply. It is strongly recommended though to watch all four videos at earliest convenience.
Timeline slide	Let's talk about the overall process and the timeline of the Action with Africa Challenge. The Action with Africa Education Module needs to be completed by May and is a supporting element to the Challenge. It shall bring everyone on the same page on how to fill in the Progress Reports properly and understand the underlying requirements better.
	The 1st Progress Report is due by 16 May 2023 at 23:59 GMT.
	The 2nd Progress Report is due by 14 September 2023 at 23:59 GMT.
	In October 2023, the TOP 6 teams will be invited to attend the Action with Africa Final Event and the Award Ceremony at the Enactus World Cup 2023 in Utrecht, Netherlands.
	If your project team fails to complete one of these stages, it will be disqualified from the Action with Africa Challenge.
AwA Program Goals	 Above all, keep in mind that the Action with Africa Evaluation Criterion deviates from the regular Enactus Criterion. The Challenge criterion also reflects the goals Positive SDG Impact Create Jobs Empower Women Activate Civil Society, agreed with the project sponsors and is an adaptation of the Enactus Criterion.

Screenshot Adobe Sign mail	Next, let's take a brief look at the Progress Report requirements: The key change compared to the previous year and other Enactus Races is that in early March you will receive an email from Adobe Sign granting you access to the 1st Progress Report form. The email contains a personalized access link which remains valid as long as you have not submitted the Progress Report. The benefit is that your entries will be saved automatically when you pause your preparation and close your browser. When you open the Progress Report form again later, the data

are still there! After submission, you will automatically receive a PDF copy. Therefore, please make sure to <u>not</u> delete the Adobe Sign email.
